September 26 ~ *Gandhi* (Attenborough • UK/India • 1982) ~ An epic historical account of Gandhi's life from young lawyer through his historic struggle to free India from colonial rule.

October 3 ~ *A Man For All Seasons* (Zinnemann • UK • 1966) ~ A profile of Sir Thomas More & his struggle of conscience with the newly forming Church of England.

October 17 ~ *Malcolm X* (Lee • USA • 1992) ~ A depiction of one man's conversion to Islam and rise to become a civil rights leader.

October 24 ~ *Romero* (Duigan • USA • 1989) ~ Portrait of El Salvador's Oscar Romero & his passionate stand against social injustice & oppression.

October 31 ~ *Anne Frank: The Whole Story* (Dornhelm • USA • 2001) ~ All-star cast brings new light to the legendary story of a young girl's endurance.

November 7 ~ *Shadowlands* (Attenborough • UK • 1993) ~ The story of C.S. Lewis' relationship with American Joy Gresham.
