This envelope contains the materials for our **2009 Faithful Journey Stewardship Campaign**. All of the **response forms** have been printed on coloured paper. There's an **Invitation to Ministry** (a list of the possible opportunities for your personal involvement in the ministries and programs at Trinity and beyond); a **Financial Commitment** form (your intended financial gifts to the church for 2010); a **PAR Enrolment/Update** form (to sign-on for or adjust your "pre-authorized remittances (PAR)"); an **Invitation To Say "Thanks"** form (your opportunity to thank an individual or a group within the congregation); a **Partners for Life** registration form. This last piece is a recent addition to the Kit.

### **Partners for Life**

Every minute of every day, someone in Canada needs blood. The good news is that one blood donation—in just one hour—can save up to three lives. Now, Trinity Lutheran Church and Canadian Blood Services are partnering to save lives together. **Trinity has joined the Partners for Life program of Canadian Blood Services.** With the commitment of Trinity members, families and friends to donate, we will be able to increase the blood collections at local blood donor clinics and ultimately help meet the growing demand for blood in our hospitals. There's a member registration form on the opposite side of this sheet. Simply fill in the form and get it in to the church. Whether they give locally or elsewhere, family and friends are also welcome to fill out a form in partnership with the people of Trinity!
